- Complete the admissions application process at Quincy University by January 18th.
- All documents (completed application and requisite materials) must be postmarked by January 18th or submitted via email by January 18th.
- Winners will be notified by phone and or email no later than March 15th.
- Scholarships will be paid directly to Quincy University and applied to the respective student's tuition account.

Scholarship recipients will be selected based on the completed application, formal essay, and the unique value the recipient brings to Quincy University. Recipients must organize a fundraiser or community outreach project with the support of their local branch of the Western Catholic Union. This is a one-year scholarship; however, candidates and recipients are encouraged to reapply each year.
