

2019 Homecoming Week Dress Code

If you would like to participate in any of the dress down days, you must purchase your homecoming shirts for \$20 during lunches Wednesday, September 4th – Friday, September 6th.

Friday, September 13th (Olympic Day):

- IF you purchased a homecoming shirt:
 - 1) You may wear jeans of a single color or khakis (no rips/holes that show bare skin; no cargo pockets; no camo or tie-dye).
 - 2) You must wear your homecoming shirt.
 - 3) St. Joe's zip-ups or sweatshirt, NO HOODS.
 - 4) You may wear ballet flats, gym shoes, or boots. No flip flops/slides, heels or slippers.
 - 5) No shorts, skirts, sweats or yoga pants are allowed.
- If you did NOT order a homecoming shirt, you must be in your uniform from the waist down (including dress shoes). You may wear Friday wear.
- Also, for our picnic lunch you are welcome to bring a blanket or towel if you wish.

Monday, September 16th – Thursday, September 19th:

- IF you purchased a homecoming shirt:
 - 1) You may wear jeans of a single color or khakis (no rips/holes that show bare skin; no cargo pockets; no camo or tie-dye).
 - 2) You must wear your homecoming shirt.
 - 3) St. Joe's zip-ups or sweatshirt, NO HOODS.
 - 4) You may wear ballet flats, gym shoes, or boots. No flip flops/slides, heels or slippers.
 - 5) No shorts, skirts, sweats or yoga pants are allowed.
- If you did NOT order a homecoming shirt, ***you must be in full uniform.***
- Junior and Senior girls are welcome to wear their powder-puff t-shirt on Wednesday (9/18).

Friday, September 20th:

- All Students:
 - 1) You may wear jeans of a single color or khakis (no rips/holes that show bare skin; no cargo pockets; no camo or tie-dye).
 - 2) You may wear your homecoming shirt or any St. Joseph/Charger shirt since it is Friday.
 - 3) St. Joe's zip-ups or sweatshirt, NO HOODS.
 - 4) You may wear ballet flats, gym shoes, or boots. No flip flops/slides, heels or slippers.
 - 5) No shorts, skirts, sweats or yoga pants are allowed
