By now you know that our Governor, in order to help prevent the spread of the coronavirus, has issued a shelter in place order beginning March 21, 2020 at 5:00 PM to April 7, 2020. Spring break for St. Joseph High School has been calendared for April 6, 2020 to April 13, 2020.

In light of this information, St. Joseph High School will remain closed until at least April 14, 2020. This closure is being initiated as a measure to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus.
