ATTENDANCE

Full attendance is essential. The intensity of the coursework demands that the student attend class everyday without exception. Since students are required to have 60 seat hours, a student must be present each and every day in order finish coursework and have credits transfer to their school. If, however, a student is too ill to be in school, a parent must call the school (708.562.4433) by 8:00AM.

Timeliness is also essential. Students must be in their classroom by the beginning of class (8:00AM or 11:30AM). Two tardies equals an absence. If a student has more than two absences FOR ANY REASON, the student will be dropped from that class, and no credit - or refund - will be given.

DRESS CODE

All students must wear khaki or black dress pants (no cargo pants with pockets) and a solid polo of any color. NO JEANS, SHORTS, or BLACK YOGA PANTS ARE PERMITTED. Students must wear socks and closed-toe shoes. Flip-flops, sandals, boots or backless shoes are not permitted. Failure to comply is cause for the student to be excluded from class and charged with an absence.

DISCIPLINE CODE

All student regulations in effect during the school year will also be observed during the summer program. Students may be dismissed for disciplinary reasons, and no refund will be issued.
