ATTENDANCE

Online daily attendance is essential. Students are required to meet with Ms. Pool on Microsoft Teams at 8:00am (and 11:30 if taking a full year or more than one class) for attendance and progress checks. The intensity of the coursework demands that the student log in to their class daily without exception. Since students are required to have 60 seat hours, a student must work online each and every day (3 hours per class) in order finish coursework and have credits transfer to their school.

A calendar with due dates and grades can be located on each students dashboard. It is important that this is checked daily to see if a student is on track or not. I will provide daily and weekly progress reports to students and parents as needed.
